

Dress Code

School Closet & School Days is OLB's official partner for uniforms. Uniform items must be purchased from them and may be done on-line or in store at 73 North Stygler Road Gahanna, Ohio 43230; 614.476.4104. Items may be picked up in store or School Closet & School Days will deliver to OLB.

We have a customized uniform website at www.schoolcloset.com. Follow these steps:

- 1. Click on "Private School" on the top tool bar.
- 2. Click on "Our Lady of Bethlehem School."
- 3. Options for approved uniform items are available for purchase here.

For ALL students (except Infant and Toddler) - Physical Education (PE) uniform:

- •Students are to wear their PE uniform to OLB on the day their class has PE.
 - Mondays Totally Terrific Twos (M/W class), Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten
 - Wednesdays Preschool
 - Thursdays- Totally Terrific Twos (T/R class)
- •PE uniform consists of:
 - OLB navy phys ed shirt (short or long-sleeve)
 - OLB gray phys ed shorts or sweats (must have the OLB phys ed logo)
 - Tennis shoes **with** socks (no crocs, sandals, boots, etc.)
 - In colder or inclement weather, a gray or white long-sleeved shirt may be worn underneath our short-sleeved PE t-shirt.

For Kindergarten students ONLY - Daily uniform:

- •Kindergarten students are required to wear an approved uniform each day.
- Approved colors for tops are navy blue and white. The approved color for bottoms is khaki. The OLB crest must be on tops or uniform jumper. This is included on articles purchased from School Closet. In colder or inclement weather, a gray or white long-sleeved shirt may be worn underneath the short-sleeved uniform shirt only.
- •Boys may wear khaki uniform shorts from the first day of school through October 31 and from April 1 through the last day of school. During all other times, boys are to wear khaki uniform pants. A belt must be worn with pants or shorts that have belt loops.
- •**Girls** may wear khaki uniform jumpers, skirts and skorts at any time. Girls may wear khaki uniform shorts from the first day of school through October 31 and from April 1 through the last day of school. Girls may wear khaki uniform pants from November 1 through March 31. A belt must be worn with pants or shorts that have belt loops.
- **Socks and Shoes:** All Kindergarten students are to wear dress shoes (ex. loafers, oxford style shoes, etc.) and ankle socks, knee socks or tights. *Approved colors for socks/tights are navy blue and white only.* Crocs, sandals, boots, etc. are not permitted. Students may only wear tennis shoes on PE days.

For Kindergarten students ONLY - Daily uniform (continued):

- **Hair and Hair Accessories:** Haircuts and styles must be appropriate. Hair length for boys must be above the ear and may not reach below the shirt collar; eyebrows should be visible. Girls may wear navy blue, white, or khaki hairband or small bow.
- **Jewelry and Accessories:** Wrist watches and fitness trackers are permitted except for those that have games, alarms, chimes, etc. Fashion/costume jewelry and temporary tattoos are not permitted.
- •Please contact the Principal if you need financial assistance with uniform costs.

For Infant, Toddler, Childcare, Totally Terrific Twos, Preschool and Pre-Kindergarten – Daily dress:

- •Please dress children in comfortable yet modest clothing according to the weather. Closed-toed and closed-back shoes or sneakers are strongly recommended for safety and comfort for children age one and older. Flip flops, heeled sandals, Croc-like shoes, etc., are not permitted. Please make sure all clothing items are marked with your child's first and last name.
- •Please provide a full set of spare clothes for Infant, Toddler, Childcare Only, Totally Terrific Twos, Preschool, and Pre-Kindergarten students in case of toileting accidents or spills during snack or lunch. If your child is in Infant and Toddler, please provide several sets of spare clothes. If your child is in school as well as childcare, please provide a second full set of spare clothes. Please make sure all clothing items are marked with your child's first and last name. Clothes should be switched out when weather changes or your child has a growth spurt.
- •If your child has a spill or a restroom accident and is sent home in clothes that belong to OLB, please launder and return them as soon as possible.

Spirit wear:

OLB has "spirit" days every Friday and several other occasions throughout the school year. Students may wear any OLB clothing or other spirit wear. Kindergarten students are excused from uniform on these days when wearing spirit attire.
